What to bring/ wear:

Pistol- preferably semi- automatic if you do not have a pistol please let us know we may have extras **For safety concerns of our students we no longer allow the Sig P320**
300 to 400 rounds of (FMJ) ball or Luger ammunition
2-3 extra magazines

Spare magazine holder- We have some extras if needed

Hard shell Holster- **strong side or appendix only**

NO BLACKHAWK SERPA ALLOWED

We have extra holsters that may fit your gun that we will bring.

A good stiff belt- (We like Nexbelt - you can find them at Murdoch's) But not necessary

Under shirt and a concealment shirt preferably one without a collar

PPE- eye and ear protection

Baseball hat

Fold out chair and table for your ammunition to sit on

Pop up shade tent if you have one or bring a buddy that has one.

Plenty of water

Pack a lunch and snacks to fuel you through the day

Recommend age: adults and kids 12 or older depending on maturity.

(Don't forget to tip your RSO) Bring a little cash

Please bring a positive attitude, open mind and a willingness to learn
